- April 1 Luke 13:34. As Jesus looked over the city knowing that He was about to be put to death, He agonized over the people and their rejection of the Fathers' love. Pray that we in this time would be filled with the same compassion for others as Jesus.
- April 2 Luke 14:3. Jesus overcame obstacles that would have prevented Him from ministering to someone who was in need. Pray that His compassion would drive us to find a way to overcome any obstacle that keeps us from being the hands and feet of Jesus.
- April 3 Luke 19:38,40. Pray that that the proclamation of the Gospel and shouts of praise to our King will drown out the fear and helplessness many are feeling now.
- April 4 Luke 21:3-4. Pray that we would understand the great value of our ministry of the Gospel to our community, that it is worth investing all we have, even our own sustenance.
- April 5 Luke 22:7-8. Leaven makes the bread puff up or become larger than it really is, spiritually it is a picture of pride, sin, and unbelief. Pray that we would confess and repent of any pride, sin, or unbelief that we may be unhindered in serving for Christ.
- April 6 Matthew 26:36. Everything trial Jesus faced he met with prayer. Pray that like Jesus, our first and utmost response to every need, every praise, is to go to Him in deep, earnest, searching prayer. Trust that He is faithful to meet our every need.
- April 7 Matthew 26:39. Pray that we would be like Jesus and put aside any will or desire of our own, any fear, and take hold of His perfect will for us as individuals and as a church body.
- April 8 Matthew 26:74-75. Pray that we would be faithful and unwavering in the face of the unknown; that we would not deny our calling to be Jesus to our community.
- April 9 Matthew 27:21. We live in a time when the world is crying out for Barabbas, the government, science, money...he has many names. Pray that many will begin to cry out for Jesus instead.

- April 10 Luke 23:46. Jesus' final words on the cross demonstrate the complete trust He had in the Father. Pray that like Jesus, we will completely trust in God and His will without fear, or hesitation, resting in His loving care.
- April 11 Pray for the Healthcare provider:

Doctor, Nurse, Respiratory therapist, CNA, Environmental service, who are serving covid patients

- God, keep them safe and healthy. Keep their families safe and healthy.
- God, help them to be knowledgeable about the diagnosis and treatment of this disease, as well as the changing protocols.
- God, help them to stay clear-minded in the midst of the surrounding panic.
- God, deliver them from anxiety for their own loved ones (aging parents, children, spouses, roommates).
- God, give them compassion for every patient in their care.
- April 12 Pray for patients who is alone in the hospital with no family to visit For those with mental health challenges who feel isolated, anxious, and helpless: God, provide them every necessary support.
- April 13 Pray for family that cannot visit their loved one or touch them physically.
- April 14 Pray for support and wisdom for our Federal, local community leaders during the COVID crisis
- April 15 Pray for those who have lost their job or laid off during the COVID crisis.
- April 16 Pray for the health of spiritual leaders and spiritual care staff so that they can pray and support others
- April 17 Pray for an area of your life that needs Victory
- April 18 Pray for patience during a time of frustration and the unknown. Pray to make time to be Still and Know that you God are in Control
- April 19 Pray for healing of mind, body and spirit
- April 20 Pray for our scientific community, leading the charge to understand the disease and communicate its gravity: God, give them knowledge, wisdom, and a persuasive voice.

- April 22 Ps. 45:17 Pray for the sick. Pray for God to bring to your remembrance all the times that He faithfully answered your prayers. Ask God for encouragement in continuing to pray in confidence that He will bring healing.
- April 23 Mark 9:28-29 Pray for our Prayer Warriors. Pray for God to give them strength to pray continually and effectively. Pray for them to be equipped with the full armor of God and able to stand in this time of need.
- April 24 Mark 10:14 Pray for the children impacted by this virus. We look at adult problems and too often forget the problems of children are as real to them as ours are to us. Help us not to be so caught up in our own problems that we can't see the reality of theirs.
- April 25 Mark 11:23-25 Pray for those who feel their faith is weak. Ask God to remind them they can move mountains if they ask according to His will. Pray for God to remove doubt and unforgiveness from our hearts and revive our spirits with your Living Water.
- April 26 Ps. 46:1-3 Pray for those who feel distanced from God. Ask God to let them see that He is "a very present help in trouble" as well as their "refuge and strength". Pray that God would use this situation to draw them back to Him and bring some good out of this calamity.
- April 27 Mark 12:28-31 Pray for your neighbors. God said that to love our neighbors is second only to loving Him. Ask God to show you who your "neighbors" are today and how you can be Christ to them.
- April 28 Mark 13:34-37 Pray today for those who have put their trust in someone or something besides Jesus. The threat of this virus will pass but still these lives will end someday. Pray that God would give them eyes to see that which is real and eternal.
- April 29 Ps. 48:9 Pray and ask God to encourage those today who have been displaced from their places of worship. Ask God to give them confidence that they will see Him in "Your sanctuary, to behold Your power and Glory".
- April 30 Mark 14:37-38 Pray for those who have grown weary in their prayers. Ask God to help them understand that sometimes they will grow weary IN the work but that He will give them the strength to not grow weary OF the work. Ask God to help us to learn from Him that... HIS work is easy and HIS burden is light.
